

Year 1 Autumn Class Report

In the first autumn term, Year 1 settled into their new classroom and we enjoyed reading our class texts of *Peace At Last*, *Can't You Sleep Little Bear* and *Where The Wild Things Are*. We also read *Billy And The Beast* as our mental health book. In science, we learned about seasonal changes. We looked at different types of weather we'd find in the different seasons.
