

Maths

We will be learning:

Calculations: mental calculations, long division, remainders as fractions, combined operations, multi-step word problems.

Fractions: simplifying fractions, comparing/ordering fractions, addition and subtraction of mixed numbers, percentages.

Ratio and Proportion: percentages of amounts, ratio, proportion.

Measurement: area and perimeter, volume, multi-step problems - measure.

Statistics: pie charts, line graphs, interpreting the mean.

Geometry: Co-ordinates, translations, reflections.

Cross curricular

We shall be learning about statistics and measures in our science and geography work.

RE

In RE we will be making links between beliefs and action and reflect how this might have local, national and international impact.

We will also be learning about the concept of Salvation - what do Christians believe God did to save human beings.

In our Social and Emotional Learning our theme will be Good to be Me.


PE

We will be exploring 1970's soul music: 'You to me are everything' and preparing for our Easter service by performing songs related to Easter.


Geography
