


## English

We shall also be learning how to spell and use words from the Year 5/6 list and exploring new grammatical terms such as relative clauses alongside adverbs, modal verbs to indicate degrees of possibility and the use of brackets, dashes and commas to indicate parenthesis.

Algebra: equations and number sequences.

Measurement: areas of triangles/parallelograms, comparing volumes and measurement problems.
