Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our Science topic this term, we will be learning about 'Animals, including Humans.' To support the children's learning, we would like to take them on an exciting visit to Hoo Farm. Details below:

- Date:** Tuesday, 16th April 2024
- Time:** Coach will collect at 9am, so please arrive at school on time. Children will be back before the end of the school day.
- Dress:** Full school uniform and warm waterproof coat/suitable footwear
- Lunch:** Bring a packed lunch, a water bottle (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). If you would like to order a school packed lunch (cost is £2.30 or free for children eligible for free school meals) please book using the meal booking system on Parentpay by **Monday 8th April at the latest.**
- Medication:** Please ensure your child has their inhaler with them if they usually bring one to school.
- The Visit:** We will be taking part in different workshops, getting up close to animals in their habitats and listening to a number of 'meet the keeper' talks.

The school is kindly subsidising this visit, however to make it feasible we will require a voluntary contribution of **£24** per child to be made via ParentPay before **Monday 8th April**. The contribution can be paid in instalments if more convenient. Unfortunately, if we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, the trip may have to be cancelled. By ticking the consent box on ParentPay, you are consenting for your child to attend the above visit and for them to travel to and from the venue by coach.

We do hope you'll agree that this is a wonderful opportunity for your child to gain an in-depth view about their topic.
